## Suit Here Calls for Destruction Of Secret Passport Office File

A suit filed yesterday calls for prohibiting and destroying a secret surveillance file of 243, 135 names in the State Depart-ment Passport Office. The file is attacked as po-tential "political blacklisting" in the suit in Federal District Court here, started by four in-the individuals were Corliss Workers party.
