U.S. Maps Appeal of Ruling

U.S. Maps Appeal of Ruling That Overturns Wiretaoping PHILADELPHIA, June 2 (AP) —The Federal Government is preparing to appeal a judge's ruling that the 1968 Federal wiretap law is unconstitutional, United States Attorney Carl J. Melone said today. "We think we are on pretty firm ground," Mr. Melone said in a telephone interview, "and that gives us justification to seek authority to file an ap-peal." The ruling was handed down yesterday by Judge Joseph S. Lord 3d in United States Dis-trict Court, who said the law was "unconstitutional on its face" because it violates the Fourth Amendment prohibition against illegal searches and in-trusions.
