

### **Stalin Museum Erases Traces of His Daughter**

GORI, U.S.S.R., Oct. 18 (UPI) — Svetlana Alliluyeva's defection to the United States has cost her her place in official Soviet history.

All trace of her has been removed from the Stalin Museum, the only memorial left to the Soviet dictator, her father. Officials have also erased, temporarily, references to her brothers, Yakov and Vasily Dzhugashvili.

Six months ago they had honored places in the museum in Gori, Stalin's Georgian birthplace. Officials do not deny that Mrs. Alliluyeva's flight had been the cause of the change.

Photos of the brothers will be returned to the museum as soon as a composite photo of the three together is redone to eliminate their sister.

Yakov died a prisoner of the Nazis and Vasily, a lieutenant general, died of alcoholism.
