Robert A. Maheu, in deposition taken today (the 12th of 14 depositions made by him, presumably on other dates) describes transaction in which Howard Hughes - through Rebozo - gave Nixon \$100,000; \$50,000 in late 1969* at San Clemente, and \$50,000 in early (?) 1970 at Key Biscayne.* Maheu says that in Makeutaxdepositions addition Hughes contributed to Nixon campaign in 1968, in the form of ten checks of \$5,000 each, through established campaign fund organizations.

Maheu's depositions are taken in connection either with his suit against Hughes, scheduled for trial 23 Oct 73, or with Hughes's mitzegainst countersuit against him. Testimony in deposition today is elicited by Hughes' lawyers and they do not ask him why Hughes would give \$100,000, in cash, to Nixon.

the IRS the date was Aug 69 but later gave IRS an amended statement, saying the delivery could have been made a year later, in Aug 70.* Maheaxeayazhexeaxpresentxouztkiaxouzusion

Danner is questioned by Ervin committee investigators 30 Aug 73; see entry that date for details.
