Sen. Jacob K. Javits warns Nixon against playing "impeachment politics" by trimming his legislative programs "to please a given number of senators: 33 plus one." NYT: "Javits, a liberal Republican who supported Mr. Nixon's candidacies in both 1968 and 1972, said he fears that the administration is abandoning legislative programs to please Senate conservatives, in the hope of gaining the 34 votes needed to block an impeachment conviction. The senator also noted that under the 25th amendment, Mr. Nixon could voluntarily relinquish office for a temporary period."
