Nixon, in Jackson, Mississippi, addresses Mississippi Economic Council, predicts (Wall Street Journal's wording) "an exceedingly bright future for the nation's economy." His mood is "euphoric ... after a rousing reception from 12,000 people packed into a coliseum here." Had taken with him on Air Force One nearly the entire Mississippi congressional delegation, "a gesture - typical of many he's made lately - that those lawmakers presumably will remember in coming days as they make decisions about his political future."
