Nixon/HJC transcripts - NYT has obtained copies of some staff memos written for members of HJC by William Patrick Dixon, a member of the staff, comparing some of the Nixon transcripts with those prepared by the committee staff. "The Dixon papers ... were the only written form of the committee version of White House tapes that committee members were free to examine outside their hearing room; the committee's own transcripts of the tapes are confined, by committee rule, to members' desks. Thus the Dixon papers found their way to newsmen - first through Democratic hands and now, in a flood, from a Republican "
