Nixon (phlebitis) - WH says Nixon was suffering from a mild case of phlebitis during Middle East trip, but condition "has now been resolved." Statement is apparently made after CBS mentioned the phlebitis tonight. See entry 26 Jun. SFC, NYT, WXP, 25 Jun 74

Nixon (mental health) - Peter Jenkins, former WX correspondent for "The Guardian" (Manchester Guardian? National Guardian?), suggests Nixon is a psychopath; gives examples of Nixon's behavior which he believes support his view. As one such example, Jenkins, after describing incident on 9 May 70, when Nixon with his valet went to Lincoln Memorial at 4:55 a.m. and Nixon discussed football with student demonstrators, goes on to say: "Then he took Sanchez on a personal sunrise tour of the deserted Capitol. At the House of Representatives, he was met by H.R. Haldeman, Ron Ziegler, and Dwight Chapin. The President climbed onto the dais, sat down, and simply stared out at the empty chamber."

Jenkins says, "His entire Presidency, the rise and fall of Richard Nixon, and Watergate too, its genesis and its meaning, begin to focus if we examine him not as a success but as a failure." (p. 49.)
