Nixon (subpoenas) - Subpoena by Jaworski for Nixon's appearance to testify at cover-up trial (? - unclear) is served on Nixon by FBI agents. (See entry 18 Sep, Nixon/cover-up trial.)

Two other subpoenas are served on Nixon at the same time by federal marshals. One is a demand by Ehrlichman's lawyers for all tapes, documents and other records "which refer to or relate to" the alleged cover-up. The other involves a civil suit brought by Henry Rothblatt, former lawyer for four of the original Watergate break-in defendants, on the grounds that his clients were pressured into firing him. Story does not say who the defendant is in this case.

This brings to five the number of subpoenas served on Nixon. The other two were served 28 Aug; see entries 27, 28 Aug.
