Korff says his organization, the President Nixon Justice Fund, has paid out \$60,000 for kmgmk Nixon's legal fees, and intends to pay Nixon's medical bills as well. Says legal bills are being submitted directly to the fund by Miller. "I have an understanding with Mr. Nixon. I get

the bills and I pay them." He estimates the legal fees and medical expenses probably will total between \$400,000 and \$500,000, with about 80 per cent of that figure going for legal expenses; as of 1 Nov the fund still owed Nixon's lawyers \$120,000 and had no more than about \$5,000 in the bank by the middle of the month.
