Nixon (1969 taxes) - IRS Commissioner Donald C. Alexander says, in intv, that Nixon has not yet paid \$171,055 additional income tax bill for 1969. UPI: "Nixon is not legally liable for the 1969 tax debt because the three-year statute of limitations expired before it was discovered. [When the tax deficit was disclosed last April] Nixon said he would pay the 1969 bill along with the principal, interest and negligence fees legally due for 1970, 1971 and 1972."

WXP 13 Jan 75 [UPI]

- Nixon paid NY taxes for 1969 on 17 Dec 74; see entry that date.

Ziegler intv - WXP says report of this intv was published "Sunday," today, does not say where it appeared. SFC carried it 13 Jan; it is entered 10 Jan, the date the intv took place.

WXP 14 Jan 75 [no attribution]

Hunt was recruited into the CIA by Frank Wisner, a deputy assistant secretary of war who had served as an OSS agent during World War II in Turkey, who later helped to set up the Office of Policy Coordination (OPC) which was later integrated into the CIA.

Dr. James Burnham, a professor of philosophy at New York University, introduced Hunt to William Buckley; when the CIA assigned Hunt to Mexico in 1950 "he soon brought Buckley aboard."
