McCord - Chief Justice Burger denies bail to McCord. "As a result, a mandate by the United States Court of Appeals affirming McCord's conviction will be issued to the trial court [tomorrow]. He will then be subject to early imprisonment unless further steps are taken in his behalf. Defense attorney William A. Mann said he was trying to decide what legal move to make next. He meanwhile has asked the Supreme Court to review the conviction."
