Hunt leaves Miami for minimum-security prison at Eglin Air Force Base, near Pensacola; is driven there by Manuel F. Artime. He will be eligible for parole 10 Jan 77, having already served 10 months of his sentence of 30 months to eight years before his release during his appeal.

Hunt's 11-year-old son, David, will live with Artime while Hunt is in prison. Hunt and Artime apparently live across the street from one another in Miami. There is no mention of Hunt's three other grown children.
