Peking Man - Interview by Mike Wallace of Dr. Harry Shapiro, of the American Museum of Natural History. During the intv, as broadcast, neither Wallace nor Shapiro mention Christopher Janus.

Wallace: Where are [the bones] now? Shapiro: I wish I knew the answer. It would give me, I can't tell you what enormous satisfaction to find them and restore them to the Chinese, where they belong. The only clues, I think, that seem to stand up is [sic] the one that is associated with the mysterious lady. Wallace [to audience]: The woman came forward in response to articles that Dr. Shapiro had written about the missing bones.

At the end of the intv Wallace says, "If the bones of Peking Man could be recovered, says Dr. Shapiro, they would make a perfect gift for President Ford to take with him on his trip to China in the Fall."
