Nixon (move to New York?) - AP story on LATimes' report of "a recent strategy meeting" (no date) at San Clemente of "political, social and business associates" of Nixon's; the only ones mentioned by name are Rebozo, Abplanalp and Mitchell.

Story says the purpose of the meeting was to discuss Nixon's future, and says he was urged to establish a new base of operations in New York; "the consensus was that Mr. Nixon should move East for greater communication with national and international leaders..... According to those who have seen him, Mr. Nixon has asked that details of their conversations not be discussed, especially in areas that might interfere with the actions of Mr. Ford, his chosen successor."

"The newspaper said its sources had stressed that no decision was imminent, but that Mr. Nixon wanted to plan his exit from his self-imposed isolation carefully and sought the counsel of familiar advisers." Nixon "[has] made no decisions yet on selling his estate in San Clemente, moving to New York or retaining his estate and setting up an office on the East Coast." AMP - A
