Mrs. Nixon's childhood home is damaged by explosion. The house, in Cerritos, had been taken over by the city as a memorial (no date), and is situated in a small park named for Mrs. Nixon; the house is open to the public only on special occasions.

An explosive device was placed, or thrown, on the front porch, resulting in damage to windows and part of the roof estimated at about \$500. Explosion occured at 2 a.m.; Los Angeles county sheriff has no suspects.
