Nixon (Senate intelligence committee) - Richard S. Schweiker (R-Pa.), a member of the committee, appears on "Face the Nation." WXP: "Schweiker said the Senate committee hasn't ruled out the possibility that [Nixon] may have known about political assassination plots in Greece and Chile. 'There's a question of calling Mr. Nixon to testify for several things. Chile would be one, Greece would be another . . . We haven't ruled that out and that is a line of investigation . . . , ' he said."
