Henry S. Ruth Jr, "who ... is on record as wanting to phase out his office sometime this fall after completion of a final report on its investigations, as the regulation creating the office permits him to do," repeats this recommendation today in testimony before Senate Government Operations Committee. He would like to leave by the end of Sep.

Ruth tells the committee that a permanent independent prosecutor, free of restraints, might create more abuses of power than remedies.

Spokesman for the special prosecutor's office confirms, 2 Sep, that Ruth has been offered a post as head of an expanded criminal justice section in the Urban Institute in WX, but has not yet decided whether he will accept the post. The Urban Institute is described by WXP as "a nongovernmental, non-profit research organization dealing with the problems of American metropolitan areas."
