Nixon (tapes and papers) - Senate Select Committee on Intelligence issues two subpoenas demanding that the WH turn over Nixon tapes and documents relating to CIA covert action on Chile and to the Huston Plan. The subpoenas are directed to Philip Buchen and to Arthur Sampson, who as head of the GSA has temporary custody of the materials.

"At the White House, an aide to Buchen ... said the Justice Department has advised Buchen not to release the documents without court permission and Nixon's lawyer, Herbert J. Miller, has threatened to seek a contempt citation against Buchen if he does." Story says the WH has already refused two written requests from the committee for the materials.

Chairman Frank Church says the committee "extended an invitation" to Nixon to testify on alleged assassination plots against foreign officials, but Nixon has declined to appear voluntarily. Church says that at present the committee is not inclined to press the matter.
