He left WX 4 Sep for two-day trip to Washington, Oregon and California; flew back to WX five hours after Lynette Alice Fromme pointed a gum at him in Sacramento. Following this incident he had a meeting with Gov. Brown, addressed the California legislature and had a press conference.
