Hunt (Jack Anderson) - Time magazine releases intv of Hunt at Eglin Air Force Base prison camp. Clippings give no date; AP says it was "after reports that the Nixon administration had put a murder contract on Anderson" (reported by WXP 21 Sep). ^{A N N - A}

Hunt says he never was ordered to kill Anderson, only to (WXP:) "make plans" to drug him. See clippings for various methods considered and discarded. Hunt says these "never got beyond the proposal stage. Liddy and I engaged in a fact-finding mission, not an operation."

Hunt says the suggestion to drug Anderson came from Colson and that "I simply followed orders." This is denied today by Colson, who says he never made this suggestion or gave Hunt such an order, and that "It is the first I heard of it."

WXP 30 Sep 75, Bob Woodward

Special prosecutor's office is investigating "allegations that there was a plot to physically injure" Jack Anderson, according to a spokesman for the prosecutor's office. WXP says this investigation was begun after it published Woodward's account (21 Sep) that Hunt had told "associates" shortly after the Watergate burglary arrests that he had been ordered by a Nixon WH official to assassinate Anderson.

- "The sources who provided the Post with the initial information about Hunt's allegations of an assassination plot against Anderson said they were particularly struck by the seriousness of it because Hunt had said it was one of two matters that had to be concealed from those investigating Watergate." The other was the burglary of Dr. Fielding's office.
