Martha Mitchell emphatically reiterated yesterday that she is through with politics and has no intention of attending the Republican national convention.

She placed a call to the Washington Post from her apartment in Washington to deny speculation in the newspaper that she might be coming down here for President Nixon's renomination.

"I am a private person," said Mrs. Mitchell, wife of the former attorney general. "I have said before that I am through with politics and I am. I have bought an apartment in New York and intend to move there as soon as we can get away.
