DULUTH (Minn.) — UPI
— Clark MacGregor, President Nixon's campaign manager, said yesterday he knows "absolutely nothing" about the bugging of Democratic National Headquarters in Washington, D.C.

The former Minnesota congressman said he had not yet received a federal court order to submit a sworn statement next Fri-

day about the incident.

MacGregor said he has no idea why he would receive the court order, since the alleged bugging took place between March and June of this year.

"You all know," he told newsmen. "That I had nothing whatever to do with the Committee to Re-elect President Nixon until the first day of July of this year."
