## Shriver Says Republicans Use CIA Tactics



## Shriver Says Republicans

Hartford, Conn.

Sargent Shriver said yesterday the Republican Party has hired people trained in CIA techniques of sabotage, forgery, bribery and espionage and brought them home "to work against the American people."

He said he believes many

Americans expressed disinterest in the break-in to Democratic headquarters in the Watergate and related matters because they thought they were only typical of what happens in Washington.

"We now have the CIA transported into the United States," he said, and added:

"When the CIA was created the CIA was denied authority to work in the U.S. The CIA tactics and techniques were developed to be used abroad against our enemies.

"What's happened is that the Republican Party has now hired these people trained in CIA techniques and put them to work inside

the U.S. using CIA techniques of sabotage, forgery, bribery, espionage, against Americans—not against our enemies, but against American people."

"This is the first time that has happened in the history of this country and the American people are going to wake up to it...," Shri-

ver said.

"This is not ordinary finagling around some politicians," he said. "This is the introduction into the life of the people of America of covert, subversive acts of the type that have only been permitted outside the U.S."
