and journalistic charges in the Watergate affair.

[Clark MacGregor? - voice unidentified:] The tactic of the McGovernites is clearly to get this White House aide to pop up here, this White House aide to pop up here, this White House aide to pop up there, with a denial, so that papers like the Washington Post - operating in at least in close philosophic and strategic and tactical cooperation with the McGovernites - will be filling their headlines full of those denials, rather than the positive aspects of the President's quest for an honorable peace in Vietnam, for example, which is the matter of topmost concern to the President right now.
