

Ehrlichman Admits FBI Election Aid

Washington - (AP) - President Nixon's top domestic adviser, John Ehrlichman, conceded today that a directive soliciting FBI information for political campaign purposes was sent out by a Justice Department subordinate, but Ehrlichman said he disapproved of it and later ordered it halted.

However, Ehrlichman said he approved of Justice Department involvement in politics and said it had to remain "responsive to the political system."
