

Mills to Seek Investigation Into Tactics of Republicans

LITTLE ROCK, Ark., Nov. 2 (AP)—Representative Wilbur D. Mills, Democrat of Arkansas, said yesterday that he would seek a Congressional investigation of Republican campaign tactics that he said added up to "the dirtiest kind of politics" in his experience.

Mr. Mills said that he wanted to find out if President Nixon had had any part in what he called a campaign to "smear" the Democratic candidates and "who in the White House directed this operation."

He said that the President might not know about such tactics and added, "but I'm satisfied that there are people in the White House who are aware of it."

Mr. Mills, chairman of the House Ways and Means Committee, told a news conference that, if something like the bur-

glary of the Democratic headquarters had taken place 20 years ago, "the people would have demanded impeachment."
