Subpoena 1972 In Political Spy Hearing

Los Angeles lawyer Donald H. Segretti has been subpoenaed by a Senate subcommittee to testify about alleged attempts to spy on the Democratic presidential candidates, it was learned yesterday.

Senate sources said that Segretti was subpoenaed to appear before the judiciary subcommittee on administrative practice and procedure headed by Senator Edward M. Kennedy (Dem-Mass.).

The sources indicated that Segretti would be called to appear for questioning behind closed doors some time before the end of the year.

The subpoena was issued to Segretti at his Los Angeles county apartment in Marina del Rey.

According to published reports, Segretti allegedly was involved in a White House-directed spying and sabo-

directed spying and sabotage operation against Demcratic candidates throughout the 1972 presidential campaign.
