Nixon Aide's New Job

President Nixon's appointments secretary, Dwight L. Chapin, whose name has been linked with the Watergate break-in case, has taken a job with United Air Lines, it was announced yesterday.

The White House said Monday that Chapin, 32, was quitting this spring to return to private business. With United, he will be a director of market planning and will join the airline in March.
