

Reagan Doesn't Agree

Governor Ronald Reagan said yesterday he does not agree with Senator Barry Goldwater's position that the Watergate bugging case could seriously hurt Republicans in the next election.

Asked about the Arizona Republican's comment that the GOP could suffer unless President Nixon dealt with the Watergate question quickly, Reagan replied: "Well I don't know whether I'll go that far."

Although he said he did not agree with Goldwater, Reagan added "I think we all want it cleared up" so

the people will "know where to assign or assess the guilt."

Last week in an interview, Reagan urged Mr. Nixon to end his grip on executive privilege and allow White House testimony on the case.
