[Newsweek Magazine says that] John DEan will be making accusations concerning the Watergate affair. The magazine claims DEan is to implicate H.R. Haldeman, John ERhlichman and others, quoting him as knowing the rocks under which the bodies are buried.

A Gallup poll claims that 4 out of 10 Americans questioned believe that President Nixon knew about the Watergate affair in advance. One in 3 feel the case has brought to light corruption in the White House.

Senator Edward Brooke of Massachusetts, a Republican, said on the NBC ~~xxxxxxx~~ broadcast Meet The Press that, as he put it, it is inconceivable that the President did not have prior knowledge of plans to bug Democratic headquarters, and former White House counsel Charles Colson has called a Los Angeles Times report linking him to Watergate "wrong", saying he did not know about it and was not connected with it in any way.
