Rogers to Leave on Extended Latin Tour

Washington

Secretary of State William P. Rogers will begin an extended trip through Latin America in early May, it was announced yesterday.

U.S. officials said it may include as many as ten nations.

Rogers is expected to visit Mexico, Colombia, Venezuela, Peru, Bolivia, Brazil and Argentina, as well as one

Central American country and another one in the English-speaking Caribbean.

State Department spokesman Charles W. Bray declined to specify the departure date or the countries to be visited.

However, other officials said the tour will begin shortly after May 1 and will include about ten capitals.
