Rogers to Leave on Extended Latin Tour

Washington

Secretary of State William P. Rogers will begin an x-tended trip through Latin America in early May, it was announced yesterday.

U.S. officials said it may include as many as ten nations.

Rogers is expected to visit Mexico, Colombia, V nezuela, Peru, Bolivia, Brazil and Argentina, as well as one Central American country and another one in the English-speaking Caribbean.

State Department spokesman Charl s W. Bray declined to specify the departure date or the countries to be visisted.

However, other officials said thetour will begin shortly after May 1 and will includ about ten capitals.
