With the Watergate case swirling steadily nearer to the White House, President Nixon canceled a scheduled meeting with his chief economic advisers and flew off last night to his monutain-top Camp David retreat.

The President decided, apparently on short notice, to spend the full weekend at his secluded retreat in the
