

Chinese Informed About Watergate

PEKING, April 27 — China's millions are being kept up to date on Watergate affair, even though public media such as the People's Daily and New China News Agency have not commented so far, on the political scandal, informed source said today.

Reports on the investigation of the bugging of the Democratic Party headquarters are being carried in a publication called Reference News, a digest of the foreign press circulated widely to leaders of various organizations, who then pass on the news through formal and informal discussions.

Reference News is one of several channels used to inform the Chinese public of world events, while newspapers, television and radio concentrate more on political commentaries and events of direct interest to China. It was through such publications as Reference News that
