Senate Probers Want FBI Files

Washington

The Senate select committee probing the Watergate bugging voted yesterday to ask Attorney General

Designate Elliot L. Richardson to make FBI files in the case available

The committee decision challenges a ruling, made in

mid-March by outgoing Attorney General Richard G. Kleindienst under orders from the White House, to limit access to the files.

The committee met for about two hours yesterday and to unanimously reaffirmed its intention to begin the hearings *United Press*
