### **Mrs. Mitchell to Give Watergate Deposition**

Mrs. John N. Mitchell, wife of the former Attorney General, is scheduled to give a deposition here today in a civil damage suit by the Democratic Committee arising from the bugging of the party's Watergate headquarters last June.

Mrs. Mitchell has been told to appear at the Manhattan office of Henry Rothblatt, a lawyer, at 2 P.M. in response to a Federal court order, the Associated Press reported.

Lawyers representing the Democratic National Committee have filed three civil suits in connection with the burglary and electronic surveillance of committee offices.

Mr. Rothblatt is counsel for James W. McCord Jr., a convicted Watergate conspirator who is a defendant in the Democrats' suit. The lawyer said that a subpoena for Mrs. Mitchell to make the deposition was issued last week.
