It was the second such revelation. The earlier case involved \$114,000 which passed through the Miami bank account of convicted Watergate conspirator Bernard Barker.

The hearing yesterday was in connection with a deposition given by Henry Buchanan, head of the accounting firm that handled the books of the Finance Committee to Re-Elect the President.

Buchanan's attorneys asked the court to keep under seal a deposition given by Buchanan in a suit filed by Common Cause, a citizen's group trying to force disclosure by the Nixon committee of pre-April 7, 1972 contributions and expenditures. Waddy deferred a decision until he reads the deposition.

But also disclosed during the hearing was that the accounting firm cashed five checks to supplement the salary of someone on the re-election committee staff, and it cashed another three checks to pay invoices.

Both sides agreed to keep under seal Buchanan's testimony relative to these eight checks.
