Agnew Denounces Techniques Of the Reporting on Watergate

CHARLOTTESVILLE, Va., May 8 (AP)—Vice President Agnew said Wednesday night that, while he applauded the role of the media in the Watergate scandal, some reporting techniques used have been "a very short jump from McCarthyism." He sharply criticized the press for what he termed its prolific use of hearsay material and for utilizing unnamed sources in an effort to substantiate its widespread allegations in the Watergate incident.

In a question-and-answer period at the University of Virginia, Mr. Agnew said the media had made a contribution in the Watergate scandal, but added:
