Government documents show that \$325,000 were transferred to a New York bank account of Costa Rican President Jose Figueres by companies linked with financier Robert L. Vesco, the Wall Street Journal reported yesterday.

Vesco, who faces criminal and civil charges in this country, is now living in Costa Rica.

According to the Journal Securities and Exchange Commission documents show that the money was transferred to the Figueres account over a period from last August to early this year.

Reached by the Journal in Costa Rica, Figueres said the \$325,000 was not his personal money but had been transferred through his personal account by other Costa Rican organizations.
