

## President Spends Sunday

At Camp David Retreat

CAMP DAVID, Md., May 20 (UPI)—President Nixon spent a rainy Sunday at his Catoctin Mountain retreat today, reviewing papers and relaxing with his wife and a friend, C. G. Rebozo of Key Biscayne, Fla.

A White House spokesman gave no indication about the subjects of the documents Mr. Nixon had with him.

He flew by helicopter to Camp David late Saturday afternoon after delivering an Armed Forces Day speech in Norfolk, Va., where he defended his actions on Indochina and emphasized his determination to continue as President despite the Watergate scandal.
