Nixon Relaxes

At Camp David

CAMP DAVID, Md., May 20 (UPI)—President Nixon spent a rainy Sunday at his Catoclin Mountain retreat, reviewing papers and relaxing with his wife, Pat, and old friend C. G. (Bebe) Rebozo of Key Biscayne, Fla.

A White House spokesman gave no indication about the subjects of the documents Mr. Nixon brought with him to study.

Mr. Nixon flew by helicopter to Camp David late Saturday afternoon after delivering an Armed Forces Day speech in Norfolk, Va., where he defended his actions in Indochina and emphasized his determination to continue as President despite the Watergate scandal.

He was expected to return to Washington late Sunday or Monday.
