A dispute over whether three local prosecutors should coninue to direct the Federal Grand Jury investigating the Westergate offsire gating the Watergate affair has developed between their has developed between their boss, United States Attorney Harold H. Titus, and the Justice Department's special Watergate porsecutor-designate. Archibald Cox. according to highly reliabel court sources. court sources.

The clash has caused an indefinite delay in prosecution of the case and no more witnesses are now scheduled to appear before the grand jury, the sources said.

Court sources confirmed the conflict yesterday after Titus prepared to announce that prosecutors from his of-fice were withdrawing from the Watergate investigation at the request of Cox.

Instead Titus announced only that he andd Waatergat prosecutors Earl Silbert Jr., Seymour Glanzer and Donad Campbell would be meeting here today with Cox.
