To Camp David

President Nixon left by auto last night for his Camp David, Md., retreat to prepare his speech for a big White House dinner for Vietnam ex-prisoners of war tonight.

The White House said Mr. Nixon would be accompanied to Camp David by his military aide, Gen. Brent Skowcroft.

While in the mountain-top retreat, Mr. Nixon also planned to read over cables from Henry A. Kissinger, who was due to return during the night from Paris, where he held six negotiating sessions with North Vietnamese representative Le Duc Tho.
