NEW YORK — (AP) —

“Watergate Scandal Game.”

The game is actually just
a deck of cards marked
Phone Tapper, Presidential
Adviser, Big Contributor,
Attorney General and oth-
ers.

The object is to do wrong
without getting caught.
When a player is proved a
liar, he must take a penalty
card and lose a certain num-
ber of points from his score.

However, a Big Contribu-
tor is fined nothing; being
asked to resign costs 10
points while being fired
costs 25; exposure by the
press is 50 points and a pris-
on sentence costs 200.
