A Watergate Counsel Is a Nixon Look-Alike Ny Jimes The New York Times WASHINGTON, May 24— The man on the television screen, the one sitting against the wall behind Senator Ed-ward J. Gurney, Republican of Florida, at the Watergate hearings, looks like President Nixon. But he's not even a relative. He is Robert Silverstein, assistant minority counsel for the Watergate committee. When he takes off his heavy rimmed glasses as the televi-sion cameras brush past the panel of Senators on the com-mittee, he confuses many Watergate TV fans. "Tve been taken for Nixon for at least 10 years," said Mr. Silverstein when asked about the resemblance. "But especially now since the Wat-ergate hearings started." Mr. Silverstein, who looks older than Mr. Nixon, says that in Washington, people mistake him for the President about five times a day.
