1973 President and Family Fly To Florida for the Weekend

KEY BISCAYNE, Fla., May 25 (AP) — President Nixon and his entire family flew here today for a holiday weekend stay. Mr. Nixon left the White House after participating in a Cabinet meeting that lasted nearly two hours.

Ronald L. Ziegler, the White House press secretary, said that the Watergate scandal was discussed briefly at the Cabinet session but that the main topic had been summit talks in Iceland next week with President Georges Pompidou of France and in Washington next month with Leonid Breznhev, the Soviet Communist party leader.
