

Julie's View on 'Crisis'

Julie Nixon Eisenhower said yesterday the Watergate affair had caused some difficult moments for her father, but added that the President "has learned to live with crises."

Mrs. Eisenhower and her husband David were here for Memorial Day services on the grounds overlooking the burial place of David's grandfather, president Dwight D. Eisenhower.

At a news conference after the ceremonies, the young couple was asked if Watergate was discussed among the family at the White House.

"In private family conversations at the White House, the subject of Watergate was never mentioned until all this came out," Mrs. Eisenhower said, adding that she believes "it is an overriding obsession with only the news media."
