A Nixon Writer Doubts President Will Resign

PORTLAND, Me., May 27

(AP)—A speechwriter for President Nixon says the Watergate scandal could never drive the President to the point of quitting.

"It's just not in his make-up," said Raymond K. Price Jr., editorial page head of the former New York Herald Tribune who has been writing for Mr. Nixon for six years.

"The worst has passed in terms of getting him down," Mr. Price said concerning Mr. Nixon in an interview Sunday with The Maine Sunday Telegram.

"He's been through other tough things. He believes in what he is doing and he believes he will have no difficulty leading the country after it [Watergate] is over."
