## Immunity for Watergate Witness

## Washington

U.S. District Court Judge John J. Sirica granted immunity to deliveryman Roy M. Sheppard yesterday to compel him to testify at Senate hearings about allegedly hauling Watergate documents away from the White House.

Sheppard's attorney, Ben W. Cotten, raised no objection to the order, but he said Sheppard has been hospitalized since Friday for high blood pressure.

Sheppard allegedly was hired to haul away eight cartons of documents the morning after the June 17 break-in at the Democratic headquarters in the Watergate complex. The documents apparently came from the White House office of E. Howard Hunt Jr., who pleaded guilty in January to being a leader of the Watergate operation.

It was not disclosed who hired Sheppard or to whom he delivered the documents.
